Glenwood Park Clean-up



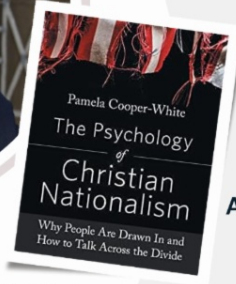

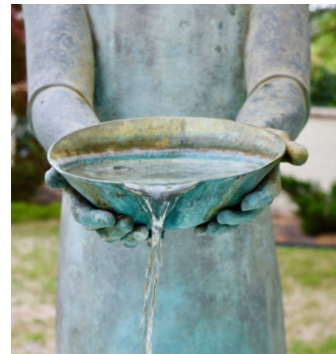
